




Do you think the government is well prepared to mitigate the impact of the predicted El-Nino rains?




"Based on our survey, 48% of Kenyans perceived government preparedness for El Niño response and impact mitigation being moderate.

This suggests that, on average, respondents believe the government is moderately prepared for addressing El Niño-related challenges and mitigating its impacts."


#### **OPINION BY REGION**
